The Milano Table

Expressive materials astoundingly arranged to form a subtle contrast: It seems that a massive oak wood panel is floating weightlessly over two t-shaped glass feet. Both elements are framed by a hand-forged stainless steel band. With this arrangement, the Swedish designer Francisco Cortina has succeeded in bringing the unique Schotten & Hansen surface closer to our hands. Our sense of touch can easily explore the structure of natural aged wood that is characterized by hollows and subtle elevations. A special eye-catcher is the end grain finish on both face sides of the table. The multi-layer engineered table core allows for a maximum dimensional stability.



Details

The table is available...

- in three dimensions size S, M & L
- in all colours of Edition Oak
- with a shrunk surface characterised by a tactile wood structure and with end grain finish on both face sides
- with a hand-finished stainless steel frame that connects the solid oak panel with the high-quality glass substructure
- The panel's height can be adjusted using an Allen screw in order to compensate for any variations in the floor level.


